There will be quiet time in the main arena for one hour following the morning session Wednesday through Saturday. Please respect your fellow exhibitors and adhere to this quiet time.

NOTICE

USEF Rule GR 901.29:(GR1301.7) Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

FEDERATION ENTRY AGREEMENT

By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaultor or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of Citrus Cup Morgan Regional Championship Horse Show. I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable - casts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4

ATTENTION COMPETITORS

Each competitor is responsible for supplying management with correct association numbers (USEF, AMHA, ASHA) for horse, owner, rider, and trainer before the day(s) of the competition.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current Federation Rule Book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.
2. All Morgan horses shown at this show must be registered with the American Morgan Horse Association, Inc., and must be entered under their full registered name, or if under one year of age, be eligible for registration. All American Saddlebred horses shown at this show must be registered with the American Saddlebred Horse Association, and must be entered under their full registered name. All classes listed in this prize list are restricted to Morgan horses UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED, OR UNLESS ENTERED IN EXCEPTIONAL CHALLENGE OR ACADEMY DIVISIONS ONLY.
3. USEF MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT: Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a 30 nonmember registration fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.
4. AMHA, ASHA & USEF membership cards must be presented at the Show Secretary's office. Please send copies of membership cards with your entries.
5. The USEF non-member fee is \$30.00. The AMHA non-member fee is \$30.00. There is no non-member fee for ASHA – you MUST be a member. The Federation Fee is \$16.00 (\$8.00 Equine Drugs & Medication, \$8.00 Federation).
6. Exhibitors must present each horse's AMHA or ASHA Registration Certificate or a photocopy of the original certificate at the Show Secretary's office. All Morgan horses must be made available for inspection by an official designated by the AMHA.

7. Entries close March 30, 2012. Entries must be postmarked by March 30, 2011. No faxed entries will be accepted. There will be a \$20.00 post entry fee per horse on all entries postmarked after March 30, 2012. No post entry penalty fee for Championship classes. Entries made the day of the show must be made at least one hour prior to the start of the session in which that class is to be held. The show office will close one hour prior to each session to allow the Show Secretary time to print class sheets. **NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER THE START OF THE SESSION FOR THAT SESSION. SCRATCH SHEETS WILL BE REQUIRED AND ARE AVAILABLE AT THE SHOW SECRETARY'S OFFICE. NO REFUND FOR CLASSES SCRATCHED AFTER THE START OF THE SESSION FOR THAT SESSION. NO ENTRIES FOR DRESSAGE CLASSES WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER MONDAY, APRIL 9, 2012.**
8. The use of attention getting devices will be enforced in accordance with GR840.
9. The Entry Blank requires 3 mandatory signatures: Owner(s), agent or trainer, and exhibitor. A coach's signature is also required, if applicable. If owner or exhibitor is under 21 years of age, the Entry Blank must be signed by a representative who is of age and who, by such signature, individually accepts responsibility and risk as stated above the signature. One owner per Entry Blank. **ENTRY, DRUG, AND STALL FEES MUST BE PAID AT THE TIME OF ENTRIES AND ACCOMPANY THE ENTRY BLANK. Make checks payable to the Florida Morgan Horse Association (FMHA).**
10. All amateur riders or drivers must have in their possession a current Amateur Certification or make application for such at the Show Secretary's office at least one hour before the class.
11. Horses can be stabled any time after 1:00 p.m. on Monday. Stalls will NOT be available until that time.
12. Stalls shall be \$95.00 for the show. All permanent stalls are solid wood and have full doors. Because of the limited number of stalls available, the Show Committee reserves the right to limit the number of tack stalls.
13. A charge of \$25.00 per day will be charged for horses without stalls.
14. Refunds on entries will be made on bona fide casualty to horse, exhibitor, or exhibitor's immediate family up to April 1, 2012. with a valid veterinarian or doctor's certificate. No refunds will be made after April 1, 2012. Refunds will be made 30 days after the show.
15. All debts incurred to the Show must be paid in full before exhibitors will be given permission to leave the show grounds.

16. All classes will receive eight ribbon placings. All prize money will be mailed within 30 days.
17. We will adhere to the 2-minute rule, unless a tack hold has been requested. All holds should be requested two classes ahead.
18. Junior Exhibitors shall not have reached their 18th birthday. The age of an individual on December 1, 2011 shall be maintained throughout the show year.
19. All horses must have a NEGATIVE COGGINS TEST within one year prior to the show date. A copy of this must accompany the Entry Blank.
20. All dogs MUST be kept on a leash or confined to stalls. (GR1301.6)
21. All exhibitors are expected to abide by USEF Rules relating to discussions with the Judge.
22. Should any questions or disputes arise that are not provided for in the foregoing rules, the same shall be referred to the Show Committee whose decision shall be final.
23. All Morgan Champions and Reserve Champions shall have one foot measured immediately upon leaving the ring.
24. The Florida Morgan Horse Association and the Canterbury Equestrian Show Place will in no way be held responsible for any loss or damage that may occur or be liable for an injury to horse, exhibitor, spectators, or any other interested party .
25. Exhibitors in classes for Ladies and Amateurs must be 18 years old or Over as of December 1, 2011. Exhibitors for Amateur Master Classes must be 50 years old or over as of December 1, 2011.
26. All rated sections are official USEF point competitions for the USEF National and Regional Horse of the Year Awards.
27. Protests will be in accordance with the USEF Rule Book.
28. Protective headgear is mandatory in all working hunter/jumper classes. And during schooling sessions for these classes.
29. Management reserves the right to refuse entries.
30. Footing in warm-up area is sand. Footing in competition arena is sand/clay composite. The warm-up area measures 150' x 300'; the competition arena measures 150' x 250'.
31. You may bring your own bedding; however, no outside vendor will be permitted to deliver bedding on the showgrounds. Bagged shavings may be purchased directly from the showgrounds through the show secretary for \$7.50 per bag, subject to change due to market price. Shavings can be preordered on the show entry form.
32. Paddocks may be rented for \$50 for the week. Golf Carts will be available for rent for \$175 for the week. Please reserve your paddock(s) and golf cart(s) on the show entry form. Camper Fee is \$35 per day.
33. Any individual including trainers, owners, exhibitors, or their agents may be fined \$100 for the improper disposal of needles or other sharp disposable instruments. Sharps containers are provided for this purpose.





UPHA Chapter 16 Academy Rules & Regulations

These rules have been established by the trainers, instructors and show committees of the UPHA Chapter 16. The Academy Division is open only to riders who have never competed in a regular horse show in full show attire for their respective division. Riders must be competing on an Academy horse. Academy classes count for THSA High Point awards.

Academy Horse is defined as a horse of any breed that is regularly used in a professionally operated lesson program. An academy horse may be privately owned, however, in addition to being used in the lesson program, someone other than the horses' owner must also show it in competition. The Academy horse must display safe manners and characteristics desired of a lesson horse. A plain shod horse is required; one pad and/or therapeutic wedge is allowed. Desired is a clean, well turned out horse, hoof blacking is optional, and braiding is only allowed in the hunt seat classes. Horses are not to be judged; way of going is not to be considered.

Tack: Horses are to be tacked according to the division the rider is competing in. Instructors are encouraged to bridle their horses in a safe manner; tie downs, standing martingales or blinkers are not allowed.

Attire: For the Saddle Seat Rider: jodhpurs, jodhpur boots or paddock boots, long sleeve, button down or collared shirt, tie and gloves are required. Vests are optional, no derbies allowed. For the Hunt Seat Rider: breeches, and an appropriate hunt seat shirt, hunt boots or paddock boots and gloves are required. "Polo" shirts are not allowed. For the Western Rider: appropriate western shirt, pants, tie, boots and gloves are required. Chaps or western hats are not allowed. In all divisions safety helmets are optional and strongly encouraged.

Class Rules: Headers are allowed in if needed for safety, no whips or towels allowed in the show ring. Classes will be split at the 13th rider; splits will be shuffled to keep Equitation and showmanship back to back for each age group. Class holds will be 2 minutes in length. NO EXCEPTIONS. Equitation Classes are judged on the riders basic equitation skills with correct diagonals and leads to be counted; proper use of the show ring is to be considered. Showmanship classes are judged on the rider's horsemanship abilities. They are judged on a rider's ability to control and show their horse, including speed, collectiveness and placement in the ring. In canter classes, promptness in finding the correct lead is important as well as the rider's command of the horse.

Exceptional Challenge Section

300. Open Exceptional Challenge Walk/Trot Showmanship - Open to all independent riders with a mental or physical handicap, riding a mare or gelding of any breed. Walk/Trot riders only.
301. UPHA Exceptional Challenge Cup - Open to all English equitation riders 12 years of age and over, with a mental or physical handicap, riding a mare or gelding of any breed. Walk/Trot riders only. To be judged on the rail and in a mandatory individual workout as a walk and trot only - one handler per entry permitted in ring. Complete class specifications, including mandatory workout, will be available in the show office.
302. Open Exceptional Challenge Walk/Trot Equitation – Open to all independent equitation riders with a mental or physical handicap, riding a mare or gelding of any breed. Walk/Trot riders only. To be judged on the rail, diagonals to count, and in a mandatory individual workout at a walk and trot only – one handler per entry permitted in ring. Mandatory workout will be available in the show office.
 - a. Level 1 – Beginners (have not shown before.)
 - b. Level 2 – Experienced (have shown before).
